When can I visit/take a tour?

Please consult our <u>Events page</u> for upcoming Tour Days, usually scheduled regularly between May 1 and October 31 every year. These events often coincide with Volunteer Days and vegan potlucks. Sign up for our <u>mailing list</u> and follow us on <u>Instagram</u> (@WildEarthFarm) and on <u>Facebook</u> to stay updated about additional Tour Days. How much does a tour cost?

Tours are \$15 for adults, \$10 for students/seniors/low income folks, \$5 for children over 5 years, \$30 for a family of 4 or more, and free for children under 5 years old. Tours are also free if you are a volunteer!

How can I pay?

You can reserve your spot by making a donation in the amount of your tour on our <u>website</u>. You can also pay with cash or check at the door.

How long is a tour?

Tours are approximately 1 hour and include learning about the rescued animals, sustainable living, homesteading, and permaculture.

Do I need to RSVP?

Yes! Please email <u>wildearthfarm@gmail.com</u> with the date you'd like take a tour as well as the number of people and ages of people in your party. We will respond to set you up with visiting details and directions to the sanctuary. Please note: the sanctuary location is NOT the mailing address posted on our website or on google maps and the sanctuary sometimes can be hard to find with GPS.

What kind of food can I bring?

Out of respect for our animal friends, Wild Earth is a vegan space. Please only bring vegan (no meat, dairy, eggs, seafood, etc) food to the farm. You are welcome to also enjoy a picnic or hike on the farm while you're here!

Can I bring my dog/cat/rat/etc?

Sorry, we cannot accommodate companion animals.

I'm coming from out of town, can I sleep at the farm?

Yes, please RSVP via email us at wildearthfarm@gmail.com if you are interested in this. We invite visitors to camp before or after the tour. Camping is \$20 per tent, \$10 per hammock, and can be paid for by making a donation-on-our-website. Camping is free for volunteers. You may bring your tent or hammock to camp under the stars, and there is a fire ring, sink, an outdoor composting toilet and a solar bag shower available for your use. Guest rooms at one of our farm houses may also be available. Just let us know that you're interested in accommodations when you RSVP!

What should I bring?

Closed-toed shoes and drinking water are a must. Bring a vegan picnic if you'd like. If you're staying for a scheduled potluck, bring your vegan covered dish, plate/bowl/cup, cutlery and ingredient list. Treats for the animals (raw fruits and vegetables such as carrots, apples, and lettuce or vegan dog treats) are a plus!
